

Minnesota Law Changes since the last DWSR update

- Move over law now includes ANY vehicle with its 4-way flashers or other warning device activated. I say you do not have to worry about normal vehicles with 4-ways on. That is no longer true. You must move over if able.
- Marijuana, up to 2 oz leaf/bud, 8 grams concentrated THC, 800 mg of edibles, can be transported IN A SEALED container. That means once opened, the broken seal is obvious.

- DWI car forfeiture law is lessened, but you can still lose your car in certain circumstances.
- Hands free phone law now says “You cannot hold, in one or two hands, any wireless communication device”.
Your car must be stopped, and **NOT IN A TRAFFIC LANE**, for you to hold your phone.
